The District School Board of Niagara is seeking to recruit at least two (2) Casual Food Service Technicians to support and work alongside Teaching Staff in Secondary School Food Service programs. Duties are expected to commence on or about February 21, 2017.

These are entry-level, on-call positions. Successful candidates would serve as substitutes for schoolbased Food Service Technicians for short-term and long-term placements, when required. The position involves assisting students with the preparation, cooking and serving of meals while maintaining a high level of cleanliness in the food preparation area. The work also involves the control and handling of cash receipts from the sale of meals and balancing of accounts.

Applicants must possess the following qualifications:

- Grade 12 education or equivalent, supplemented by courses in quantity cooking;
- 1-2 years of experience in commercial or institutional food preparation and service;
- Demonstrated ability to work well with students as well as colleagues;
- Strong knowledge and commitment to food safety and sanitation;
