COURSE CANCELLATIONS

If none of your choices are available because of lack of enrolment, you will be notified by phone or email on Friday, June 29 or Monday, July 2, 2012. The courses being offered online are listed below and are subject to sufficient enrolment.

REGISTRATION

If you have pre-registered for a course through your Guidance Department, you will automatically be put on a class list. You will receive confirmation of enrolment via the email address provided. You may only register in ONE online course.

Student emails should be ACTIVE and checked regularly. Occasionally registration emails will be directed into Junk mail boxes (please check these regularly as well). More details regarding course access will be provided via email once a student has registered.

LATE REGISTRATION

Completed Summer School applications (signed by your Home School Principal) will be accepted for all new credit eLearning courses if entered into the eLearning Registration System by your home school guidance counsellor or in person at Sir Winston Churchill Secondary School or A.N. Myer Secondary School on Tuesday, July 3, 2012.

ATTENDANCE

Course material is covered in a short period of time in Summer School, therefore it is very important that online attendance and participation be made a priority. Course material will be delivered in an eLearning (online) format, and it is suggested that all students attend an orientation at one of the Summer Semester locations (see Orientation info below). Students must complete an online orientation module before they begin to work on their course. Students and their families must ensure that summer jobs, holidays and other activities do not jeopardize their enrolment status. Note: Civic Holiday – Monday, August 6, 2012, no classes. The final evaluations will be conducted online as outlined by the course syllabus and must be completed on Tuesday, August 7 or Wednesday, August 8, 2012 (students must be available on these dates as requested by the teacher).
