This application is for courses previously taken and failed, OR to upgrade a passing mark to a higher mark in that subject. You MUST have taken the exact course in the past school year to upgrade your mark in the remedial program.

Grade 10 Career Planning and Civics remedial courses, which are 0.5 credit each, will be offered starting Tuesday, July 3 until Friday, July 20, 2012, (13) days, for 2 hours and 20 minutes per day per course.

COURSE CANCELLATIONS

If none of your choices are available because of lack of enrolment, you will be notified by phone on Friday, June 29 or Monday, July 2, 2012.

REGISTRATION

If you have pre-registered for a course through your Guidance Department, you will automatically be put on a class list. You WILL NOT receive confirmation of enrolment. On the first day of school, students must plan to arrive early to check the posted class lists to check the timetable to see where their class will be held. The courses being offered at A.N. Myer S.S. and Sir Winston Churchill S.S. are provided on the attached listing and are subject to sufficient enrolment (minimum of 20 students per class). **Please indicate your choice(s) on the registration form. If you have requested two courses and there is a scheduling conflict, you will be notified by phone. Students must be prepared to accept the class time assigned.**

LATE REGISTRATION

Completed Summer School application (signed by your Home School Principal) will be accepted for all remedial credit courses at the Summer School sites in person starting at 8:00 am on Tuesday, July 3, 2012.

ATTENDANCE

Course material is covered in a short period of time in Summer School, therefore, it is very important that attendance and punctuality be made a priority. Students who miss more than 3 days, or are habitually late, may be deleted from the course. Students, and their families, must ensure that summer jobs, holidays and other activities do not jeopardize their enrolment status. The final exam will be written on Friday, August 3, 2012. **Remedial courses are run from 8:30 am to 10:50 am, and from 10:50 am to 1:10pm.**

TRANSPORTATION

BUS ROUTES/BUS PASS

A schedule of bus routes, times and pick up points will be available through your Guidance Office prior to Wednesday, June 27, 2012. Eligible students will be issued a Summer School bus pass during the first week of summer school. Commencing Monday, July 9, 2012, students will not be allowed on the bus without a bus pass.

Students travelling from Beamsville, Grimsby and Niagara-On-the-Lake areas will be provided with transportation to Sir Winston Churchill Secondary School. There is no transportation provided for students living in urban St. Catharines/Thorold to any summer school sites.
