COURSE CANCELLATIONS

If none of your choices are available because of lack of enrolment, you will be notified by phone on Friday, June 29 or Monday, July 2, 2012. The courses being offered at A.N. Myer and Sir Winston Churchill are provided on the attached listing and are subject to sufficient enrolment (minimum of 20 students per class).

REGISTRATION

If you have pre-registered for a course through your Guidance Department, you will automatically be put on a class list. You WILL NOT receive confirmation of enrolment. On the first day of school, plan to arrive early to check the posted class lists to see where your class will be held. **Please indicate your first choice and alternate choice on the registration form. If your first choice course is cancelled, you will automatically be enrolled in your alternate choice course.**

LATE REGISTRATION

Completed Summer School applications (signed by your Home School Principal) will be accepted for all new credit courses at the Summer School sites in person starting at 8:00 a.m. on Tuesday, July 3, 2012.

ATTENDANCE

Course material is covered in a short period of time in Summer School; therefore, it is very important that attendance and punctuality be made a priority. Students who miss more than 3 days, or are habitually late, may be deleted from the course. Students, and their families, must ensure that summer jobs, holidays and other activities do not jeopardize their enrolment status. The final exam will be written on Friday, August 3, 2012.

TRANSPORTATION

BUS ROUTES/BUS PASS

A schedule of bus routes, times and pick up points will be available through your Guidance Office prior to Wednesday, June 27, 2012. Eligible students will be issued a Summer School bus pass during the first week of summer school. Commencing Monday, July 9, 2012, students will not be allowed on the bus without a bus pass.

SIR WINSTON CHURCHILL SECONDARY SCHOOL, ST. CATHARINES, SITES

Students travelling from Grimsby, Smithville, Beamsville, and Niagara-on-the-Lake areas will be provided with transportation to Sir Winston Churchill Secondary School. There is no transportation provided for students living in urban St. Catharines/Thorold to any summer school sites.

A N MYER SECONDARY SCHOOL, NIAGARA FALLS, SITE

Students travelling from Fort Erie, Wainfleet, Fonthill, Welland and Port Colborne areas will be provided with transportation to A N Myer Secondary School. There is no transportation provided for students living in urban Niagara Falls to any summer school sites.

EASTDALE SECONDARY SCHOOL, WELLAND SITE (PPL201 Only)
