FUN & FIT Physical Education & Health 1.0 CREDIT (Grade 7 & 8 students) This course emphasizes regular participation in a variety of physical activities that promote lifelong healthy living. Students will participate in a variety of activities that will enhance their personal confidence, fitness and health. They will examine topics related to healthy living, the use of informed decision making and positive social recreational activity.

ROBOT RUMBLE Computer Technology 1.0 CREDIT (Grade 7 & 8 students)

Let's get ready to RUUUMBLE! In the Robot Rumble course you will learn about computers, programming, electronics and control systems all while building your own sumo robot. Each student will have the opportunity to build a small battle ready robot using an Arduino controller. At the end of the course your robot will battle for the ultimate prize (or at least bragging rights). Join us at Grimsby Secondary for this action packed course!

ART ATTACK Integrated Arts 1.0 CREDIT (Grade 7 & 8 students)

This course integrates four of the arts (drama, media arts, music, and visual arts), giving students the opportunity to produce and present integrated art works created individually or collaboratively. Students will demonstrate innovation as they learn and apply concepts, styles, and conventions unique to the various arts and acquire skills that are transferable beyond the classroom. Students will use the creative process and responsible practices to explore solutions to integrated arts challenges

CIVICS & CAREERS

Civics .5 Credit explores what it means to be an informed, participating citizen in a democratic society. Students will learn about elements of democracy and the meaning of democratic citizenship in local, national and global contexts.

Careers .5 Credit teaches students how to develop and achieve personal goals in education and work and contributing to their communities. The course explores post secondary learning options, prepares students for community-based learning and helps them build the capabilities needed for managing work and life transitions.

COURSE CANCELLATIONS

You WILL NOT receive confirmation of registration received or enrolment if the course is running.

If the course is not available because of lack of enrolment, you will be notified by phone the Saturday before the course starts.

ATTENDANCE

Course material is covered in a short period of time in Summer School, it is very important that attendance and punctuality be made a priority. Students who miss more than 3 days, or are habitually late, may be deleted from the course. Students, and their families, must ensure that summer jobs, holidays and other activities do not jeopardize their enrolment status. The final exam will be written on Friday July 28, 2017.

TRANSPORTATION

Transportation may be provided at no charge for students who attend summer school courses and reside in areas not serviced by public transit as approved by the District School Board of Niagara. Summer school buses cover large rural geographical areas and parents/guardians are responsible to arrange getting their children to and from centralized bus stops located within their community. Students must follow the bus rules on routes to and from Summer School otherwise transportation privileges may be revoked.

Students will be permitted to board the buses at the designated stops for their chosen summer school site as listed on the bus transportation schedule The bus transportation schedule will be available online at <u>www.dsbn.org/summer</u> in June and at all DSBN elementary schools

Students travelling from Fort Erie, Wainfleet, Fonthill, Welland or Port Colborne areas may be provided with transportation from centralized locations to one of the following program sites: Niagara Falls- Westlane Secondary School, 5960 Pitton Rd. Welland Site School or St. Catharines Laura Secord Secondary School, 349 Niagara St.

Students travelling from Jordan, Vineland, Caistor, Gainsborough and Smithville areas may be provided with a community stop to one of the following program sites: Grimsby Secondary School, 5 Boulton Ave. or Beamsville Secondary School, 4317 Central Ave.

There is no transportation provided for students living in urban areas of the summer program sites.

Parents/guardians are responsible to arrange transportation for students who are not eligible for service.
