ELD A, B, C OR D, OPEN – 1.0 Credit

This course is open to all students in both the ESL and ELD pathways to English language proficiency. Students will work towards one of ELD, A, B, C, OR D credits based on their level of English language proficiency. An ELD credit can be substituted for a compulsory English credit towards an Ontario Secondary School Diploma. The English Literacy Development course provides an accelerated program of literacy development for students requiring more intensive support for a longer period of time. Skills acquired in the ELD course will benefit students working towards ESL, ELD, the Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test, and all mainstream curriculum courses. Components of the curriculum include listening and speaking, reading, writing, and socio-cultural competence and media literacy.

ATTENDANCE

A great deal of material is covered in a short period of time in Summer School; therefore, it is particularly important that students make attendance and punctuality a priority. Students who miss more than 3 days, or are habitually late, may be deleted from the course. Students, and their families, must ensure that summer jobs, holidays and other activities do not jeopardize their enrolment status. The final exam will be written on August 3rd.
