1. Only authorized persons may implement the *Trespass to Property Act* and the *Occupiers' Liability Act*, therefore, in order to implement the *Trespass to Property Act* and the *Occupiers' Liability Act*:
 - (a) All employees of the District School Board of Niagara shall be designated as Authorized Persons.
 - (b) Signs, in accordance with the *Occupiers' Liability Act*, shall be ordered through the Plant Department.
 - (c) Signs, in accordance with the *Occupiers' Liability Act*, shall be posted on school sites and Board premises.

2. Under the *Trespass to Property Act*, a School Board has all the rights of an "occupier" to maintain control over each school site, which is broadly defined to include the school building, playground, gymnasium, offices and parking area, etc., and Board premises. All employees shall strive to ensure that only those with a legal right under the *Education Act* are present on school sites and Board premises during school hours or school and Board sponsored activities.
