DSBN Tech Team Heads to Waterloo for Provincial Technology Competitions

This week, technology students from the District School Board of Niagara will be competing against teams from across Ontario at the 18th Annual Skills Canada – Ontario technology competitions.

After one month of local competitions where 3800 DSBN students participated in 32 challenges, Team DSBN has been chosen. 50 students from both elementary and secondary schools who successfully competed in local competitions, will head to Waterloo this week to compete against 2000 students from across Ontario for a chance at the provincial podium and the honour of becoming part of **Team Ontario!** Team Ontario will compete on a national level at Skills Canada in Saskatoon 2007.
