This application is for courses previously taken and failed, OR to upgrade a passing mark to a higher mark in that subject. You **MUST** have taken the exact course in the past school year to upgrade your mark in the remedial program.

Grade 10 Career Planning and Civics remedial courses, which are 0.5 credit each, will be offered starting Wednesday, July 2 until Friday, July 15, 2014, (10) days, for 2 hours and 30 minutes per day per course.

COURSE CANCELLATIONS

If none of your choices are available because of lack of enrolment, you will be notified by phone on Tuesday July 1, 2014.

REGISTRATION

If you have pre-registered for a course through your Guidance Department, you will automatically be put on a class list. You **WILL NOT** receive confirmation of enrolment. On the first day of school, students must plan to arrive early to check the posted class lists to check the timetable to see where their class will be held. The courses being offered at A.N. Myer S.S. and Sir Winston S.S. are provided on the attached listing and are subject to sufficient enrolment (minimum of 20 students per class). **Please indicate your choice(s) on the registration form. If you have requested two courses and there is a scheduling conflict, you will be notified by phone. Students must be prepared to accept the class time assigned.**

LATE REGISTRATION

Completed Summer School application (signed by your Home School Principal) will be accepted for all remedial credit courses at the Summer School sites in person starting at 8:00 am on Wednesday, July 2, 2014.

ATTENDANCE

Course material is covered in a short period of time in Summer School therefore, it is very important that attendance and punctuality be made a priority. Students who miss more than 3 days, or are habitually late, may be deleted from the course. Students, and their families, must ensure that summer jobs, holidays and other activities do not jeopardize their enrolment status. The final exam will be written on Tuesday July 15, 2014. **Remedial courses are run from 8:30 am to 1:20pm.**

TRANSPORTATION

Transportation may be provided at no charge for students who attend school summer courses and reside in areas not serviced by public transit as approved by the District School Board of Niagara. Summer school buses cover large rural geographical areas and parents/guardians are responsible to arrange getting their children to and from centralized bus stops located within their community. Students must follow the bus rules on routes to and from Summer School otherwise transportation privileges may be revoked.

Students will be permitted to board the buses the first week of summer school without an identification card. After that, only those students who present an approved Transportation Identification Card will be permitted to board the bus. Transportation identification cards may be obtained from the Summer School office located at the Summer School site.

Parents/guardians are responsible to arrange transportation for students who are not eligible for service.

SIR WINSTON CHURCHILL SECONDARY SCHOOL, ST. CATHARINES SITE

Students travelling from Beamsville, Grimsby, West Lincoln and Niagara-on-the-Lake areas will be provided with transportation to Sir Winston Secondary School. There is no transportation provided for students living in urban St. Catharines/Thorold to any summer school sites.

A.N. MYER SECONDARY SCHOOL, NIAGARA FALLS SITE

Students travelling from Fort Erie, Wainfleet, Pelham, Welland and Port Colborne areas will be provided with transportation to A N Myer Secondary School. There is no transportation provided for students living in urban Niagara Falls to any summer school sites.
