## Field Technician Casual Position

The District School Board of Niagara is seeking to recruit a casual Field Technician.

The functions of this position include (but are not limited to):

- Installation/configuration of audio visual equipment such as LCD projectors, Interactive projectors and boards, classroom audio and audio speakers
- Pickup of surplus equipment in all DSBN locations for redistribution or recycling
- Assist Computer Technicians with the installation, setup, troubleshooting, repairing and maintaining a variety of hardware including: desktop computers, laptops, netbooks, tablets, IP phones, printers, patch panels, network switches, cameras, interactive whiteboards and projectors, and other peripherals
- Provide assistance to Chief and Computer technicians in a variety of roles as necessary through the course of a typical school year. These roles will continually evolve with the technology being deployed.
- Service call management including detailed documentation of problem resolution using Service Desk software (Topdesk), department sign out system and any other communication tools required
- Repair/maintenance work at various heights using ladders is required
- Travel to schools or bench work & support in the office is required

Applicants must have a minimum of (3) years related experience, specifically in relation to audio visual installation and configuration and show proof of a valid driver's license. Preference will be given to candidates familiar with DSBN Facility Services processes, including specifically asbestos report understanding.
