The District School Board of Niagara is currently seeking a Master Mechanic / Maintenance Mechanic. The successful applicant should have the following requirements:

- Must have a minimum of 5-years hands-on experience with institutional/commercial hydronic heating systems. To be considered, applicants must have a current certification in one or more of the following:
 - Construction Boilermaker – 428A (Ontario College of Trades)
 - Refrigeration and Air Conditioning Systems Mechanic – 313A (Ontario College of Trades)
 - Industrial Mechanic Millwright – 433A (Ontario College of Trades)
 - G.1 or G.2 certificate (O. Reg 215/01)
 - IMT Certification (O. Reg 215/01)
 - Plumber – 306A (Ontario College of Trades)
- Must have a thorough understanding of current, trade related codes and gas codes.
- Must be able to work from blueprints and be computer literate.
- Must have a thorough, hands-on working knowledge of institutional /commercial gas-fired hot water boilers, air handlers, unit ventilators and other related HVAC equipment.
- Must be capable of troubleshooting, repairing, installing and maintaining mechanical systems as well as carry out preventative maintenance on the above-mentioned equipment.
- Experience diagnosing, maintaining and correcting problems relating to HVAC systems is preferred.
- Must have experience with pneumatic and DDC controls as it relates to sensors, dampers, valves, actuators, VAV boxes and other HVAC controls.
- Must have knowledge of the theory and requirements of systems as it relates to HVAC commissioning.
- Must have a working knowledge of pneumatic and DDC control systems.
- Must be able to work in confined work areas, as well as on ladders, scaffolding and lifts.
- Must have a valid Ontario Driver's License.
- The above describes only the primary requirements of this position and should not be considered to encompass all responsibilities and tasks that may be assigned.
