The successful applicant will provide direct social worker services to students and families in schools or alternate programs. He/she will work cooperatively with system and community mental health professionals in an educational environment dedicated to providing the highest standards of service. The successful applicant will be part of a multi-disciplinary team working directly with administration, staff, students and families. The successful candidate will:

- possess excellent communication skills (written and verbal);
- possess strong interpersonal skills and excellent organizational skills;
- work collaboratively with schools (administration and school staff) regarding behavioral management, social-emotional issues, social skills development, and **anger** management to facilitate academic success for students;
- provide support in responses to crisis/tragic events;
- provide risk assessments and developing risk-management plans for students who exhibit violent behaviours that put themselves and/or others at risk;
- offer clinical crisis intervention and support to students and families;
- liaise with community agencies to ensure effective responses to students and families;
- demonstrate ability to work as part of a multi-disciplinary team;
- provide professional development opportunities, as directed; and
- carry out other professional duties as assigned.

Qualifications Required:

- Completion of a Masters Degree in Social Work (M.S.W.).
- Registration with the Ontario College of Social Workers and Social Service Workers.
- Valid Driver's License and ability to travel between schools and Board sites.
- Membership in the Ontario Association of Social Workers preferred.
- 5 years experience in a community or educational setting an asset
