

Indigenous Education Council

Meeting Notes

November 14, 2024 @ 5:30 p.m.

- 1. Marianne Groat, Student Achievement Leader for Indigenous Education, welcomed all attendees to the meeting.
- 2. Corry Carter, Indigenous Languages Consultant, provided a traditional opening in Mohawk.
- 3. Marianne Groat introduced the DSBN Indigenous Education Team and external consultant, Georgie Groat, who has been hired to help re-imagine the DSBN Indigenous Education Council structure for 2024/2025.
- 4. Georgie Groat provided a brief history of the Indigenous Education Advisory Council in Niagara. She highlighted struggles with attendance/quorum, and feedback provided by previous members on the challenges of the past structure. She shared details about the plan to re-imagine the Indigenous Education Council (IEC) in a way that provides a way of meeting that meets Ministry Criteria with a student focus. The aim is to seek authentic feedback and guidance to shape the work.
- 5. Georgie Groat briefly reviewed the Board Action Plan requirements and the DSBN Strategic Plan Goal "Walking Together".
- 6. Clayton Mishibinijima spoke about his role as Indigenous Student Trustee as well as his experience as a DSBN student. He also read a submission from Indigenous Student Leader Rayna Bristow.
