

Updated COVID-19 February 2021 Entry Registration: Tuition Deferral/Refund Policy October 2020

District School Board of Niagara, Ontario, Canada International Student Program

If you are applying to study at the DSBN for February 2021 entry as a new or returning student, but are unable to travel to Canada before the start of the semester, due to the spread of COVID-19, the following options regarding registration will be available:

- 1. You can request to <u>defer</u> your registration to the September 2021 entry. A \$150 CAD deferral fee will be waived and a new Letter of Acceptance will be issued, if deferral is received <u>before January 31, 2021</u>; OR
- 2. You can request to <u>withdraw</u> your registration. Full tuition refund (less \$150 CAD administrative fee, instead of the usual \$400 CAD) will be granted, if withdrawal is received <u>before January 31, 2021</u>.
- 3. If you want to continue <u>registration</u> with us for the February semester for online/remote learning, no tuition fees will be refunded.

Please be aware that the February semester will not be a typical school experience, for example: some online learning; alternating days in class; no sports/clubs; online learning due to a possible second wave of coronavirus, etc.
