



- •Start with Integrated Technology (TIJ), then choose one of the ten Technology areas to match your interests.






















Summer Program

- Introduction to Technology Courses.











WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR OYAP PARTICIPATION?

•You must be at least 15 years old (in most cases), have completed 14 credits toward your OSSD, enrolled as a full-time or part-time student in a secondary school, and in a Co-op placement that is an apprentice trade.

Benefits for Students

- •OYAP lets you participate while you are taking Co-op placements in skilled trades;
- •Train on-the-job in one of over 140 apprentice trades in 4 different sectors including:
 - * Service * Construction * Motive Power * Industrial









- •Earn Co-op credits (as early as the summer between grades 10 and 11), gain work experience and try out an apprenticeship;
- •Get signed as a Registered Apprentice in high school and you'll begin counting competencies / hours toward becoming fully qualified;
- •Make industry contacts to help you make training/career decisions and who may offer future job opportunities;
- Form a seamless pathway to postsecondary apprenticeship training!















Yearly Technological Skills Challenges

•These challenges allow students to showcase their classroom learning and bring it to the next level by participating in one of over 25 different challenges;



- •The individual competitions have their own set of skills that are directly related to curriculum and enhance prior learning;
- •These sector skills are also combined with real-life situations such as meeting timelines, problem solving, creativity and many more;
- •Students learn life skills that are transferable for post-secondary options that they may pursue;
- •Each year we take two buses of students to the Provincial Skills Challenges and some move on to National challenges.
