




## What is digital literacy?

Digital literacy involves the ability to solve problems using technology in a safe, legal, and ethically responsible manner. With the everexpanding role of digitalization and big data in the modern world, digital literacy also means having strong data literacy skills and the ability to engage with emerging technologies. Digitally literate students recognize the rights and responsibilities, as well as the opportunities, that come with living, learning, and working in an interconnected digital world.








38 per cent of adults think teens should spend less time online....

- Help children learn to handle both their own and others' information with care




























