This application is for courses previously taken and failed. You MUST have taken the exact course in the past school year to upgrade your mark in the recovery program.

Grade 10 Career Planning and Civics recovery courses, which are 0.5 credit each, will be offered starting Wednesday, July 4 until Tuesday July 17, 2018 for 2 hours and 30 minutes per day per course.

COURSE CANCELLATIONS

If your choice is not available because of lack of enrolment, you will be notified by phone the Saturday before the course start date.

REGISTRATION

You WILL NOT receive confirmation of registration received or enrolment. If you have registered for a course through your Guidance Department, or submitted the registration yourself, you will automatically be put on a class list. On the first day of school, students must plan to arrive early to check the posted class lists to check to see where your class will be held. The courses being offered at A.N. Myer S.S., and Sir Winston Churchill S.S. are provided on the attached listing and are subject to sufficient enrolment (minimum of 20 students per class).

LATE REGISTRATION

Completed Summer School registration (signed by your Home School Principal) will be accepted for all remedial credit courses at the Summer School sites in person starting at 8:00 am on Wednesday, July 4, 2018.

ATTENDANCE

Course material is covered in a short period of time in Summer School therefore, it is very important that attendance and punctuality be made a priority. Students who miss more than 3 days, or are habitually late, may be deleted from the course. Students, and their families, must ensure that summer jobs, holidays and other activities do not jeopardize their enrolment status. The final exam will be written on Tuesday July 17, 2018.

VISA FEE PAYING STUDENTS

Students registered in a day school as a VISA student will be required to pay a fee of \$550 to take a summer school credit course. Payment will be required before the start of the program and the fee paid by cash or cheque (made payable to the DSBN) are to be brought to the Adult & Community Education office at 535 Lake St, St. Catharines in the Lifetime Learning Centre, Room 101, Monday to Friday 9:00 am to 3:30 pm

TRANSPORTATION

Transportation may be provided at no charge for students who attend summer school courses and reside in areas not serviced by public transit as approved by the District School Board of Niagara. Summer school buses cover large rural geographical areas and parents/guardians are responsible to arrange getting their children to and from centralized bus stops located within their community. Students must follow the bus rules on routes to and from Summer School otherwise transportation privileges may be revoked.

Students will be permitted to board the buses at the designated stops for their chosen summer school site as listed on the bus transportation schedule. The bus transportation schedule will be available online at www.dsbni.org/summer

Parents/guardians are responsible to arrange transportation for students who are not eligible for service.

SIR WINSTON CHURCHILL SECONDARY SCHOOL, 101 GLEN MORRIS DRIVE, ST. CATHARINES SITE

Students travelling from Beamsville, Grimsby, West Lincoln and Niagara-on-the-Lake areas will be provided with transportation from centralized locations to Sir Winston Churchill Secondary School. **There is no transportation provided for students living in urban St. Catharines/Thorold to the St. Catharines/Thorold summer school site.**

A.N. MYER SECONDARY SCHOOL, 6338 O'NEIL ST, NIAGARA FALLS SITE

Students travelling from Fort Erie, Wainfleet, Pelham, Welland and Port Colborne areas will be provided with transportation from centralized locations to A.N. Myer Secondary School. **There is no transportation provided for students living in urban Niagara Falls to the Niagara Falls summer school site.**
