- A wide selection of university-preparation and college-preparation courses are offered as well as ESL supports.
- 90% of international students at Sir Winston Secondary School graduate to reputable post-secondary institutions in Ontario, across Canada, the USA, and worldwide (89% to universities; 1% to colleges of applied arts & technology).
- 1% of the Sir Winston 900 total student body is comprised of English Language Learners from a variety of language backgrounds.

Sir Winston Churchill Secondary School is located in the city of St. Catharines in close proximity to Brock University; the Pen Centre – a large shopping mall in the Niagara Peninsula – and within walking distance from the beautiful hiking trails of the Niagara Escarpment.

It offers a wide range of high-school credit courses at both the Academic (university preparation) level and the Applied (College preparation) level. Sir Winston students achieve excellent results on the provincial standardized tests of Math, Literacy, and Science.
